Autumn Training of the Physics Olympiad 2021

Due to the current health situation, this year's Physics camp is replaced by an alternative event: the Autumn Training.

Concept	You will receive weekly Challenges from us during 6 weeks. These are adapted to the difficulty of the 2 nd round. You have 10 days to solve and submit each challenge. Every Saturday we offer online coaching sessions. There our helpers will answer your questions about the challenges and the topic. If you submit 4 or more assignments (meaningfully worked on), we will reward you with a little surprise.
Participation	Participation is of course voluntary and has no influence on the 2^{nd} round. However, the autumn training offers you a good preparation for the 2^{nd} round and the opportunity to explore new topics.
Communication	You will receive the challenges as well as all other information by email each week. The solved assignments have to be sent to physics.autumn-training-inbox@olympiad.ch and you will receive the correction by email as well.

	• The challenges will be published every week on Friday morning (first on 22.10.2020, last on 26.11.2020).
	• The submission deadlines are on the Monday 10 days after the publication of the Challenge (23:59). (first 01.11.2020, last 06.12.2020).
	• The coaching sessions take place on the Saturday before the submission deadline (first 30.10.2020, last 04.12.2020).
Local Meetings	On 6.11.2021 (Zurich), 20.11.2021 (Bern) and 4.12.2021 (Lausanne) there will be training sessions in the morning where you can solve exercises with the help of tutors, afterwards we will have lunch together. Please only participate in one of those three mornings. In the afternoon, we organise excursions in the region, which are open to all participants. We will communicate the valid Covid protection concepts together with the exact programme and the registration form in good time.
Coaching	The languages offered for each coaching session are based on the availability and language skills of the helpers. We will communicate this weekly in the invitation email.
